Eligibility

This contest is open to students in grades 6-12 (or equivalent) who are Henrico County residents, or students who hold a Henrico County Public Library card.

Entries should be at least 4" x 6" and no larger than 8 ½" x 14".

Entries are the property of HCPL and will not be returned.

All entries must be the original work of the entrant.

Artwork should be in color. Computer-generated images may be used, but all components must be completely original. You may not use any copied images.

Entries are limited to two (2) original pieces, digital art, or scanned art per student with a completed entry form attached to each; no staples please.

Rights of HCPL to use submitted artworks

Submission of a signed entry form grants consent and verifies that the entrant created the artwork. Your entry to the contest constitutes a grant from you to Henrico County Public Library (HCPL) of a free perpetual non-exclusive license authorizing your artwork to be displayed by HCPL or by third parties with HCPL's permission, to be used on the HCPL website, and to be used in HCPL advertisements and other HCPL promotional material. All entries must be free of claims and rights of third parties. HCPL reserves the right to make minor modifications to art, text and context. HCPL is not responsible for damage to or theft of artwork.
